## Sample budgets for hosting grant

Teiger Foundation aims to offer guidance on your existing project budgets, rather than requiring the creation of new ones. Choose the budget type that best aligns with your program's financial needs—these examples are meant to give you an idea of what information to include, but they are not exhaustive.

These sample budgets are based on actual applicant submissions, which is why you may notice varying emphases on program elements, as well as differences in terminology and organizational structures.

## Please keep in mind:

- Budget numbers provided here are rounded, approximate figures (not precise calculations).
- Shipping costs labeled "out" or "in/out" represent the maximum amount an institution might pay; if additional venues are added to the tour, these costs are shared and decrease proportionally. The last venue is typically responsible for dispersal costs.
- Host applicants may have limited control over shipping decisions, including sustainability considerations. We encourage hosts to initiate early conversations with the originating curator when planning to apply.
- Sustainability considerations will be discussed further in a Foundation-led webinar in Fall 2025.
- W.A.G.E. standards are met only where explicitly noted in the budgets.

At the top of each budget you will find the **organization budget size**, **organization type**, **and a brief project description**, followed by expenses, income, and notes. Applicants are encouraged to review the example most closely aligned with their own structure and scale.
